With ANZAC Day quickly approaching, the planning committee has preparations well in hand for 25 April 2021. Our usual four services will be conducted at the Cenotaph/RSL Hall, Hospital and Witta:

0428: Dawn Service (Cenotaph)

0900: Witta Cemetery

0945: Maleny Soldiers' Memorial Hospital

1015: Assemble for March (cnr Fig and Maple Streets)

1045: Call to order for Main Community Service at Cenotaph/RSL Hall

Breakfast (\$5) will be served after the Dawn Service and Lunch (\$15) will be served in the Hall after the main service. A barista will be serving coffee (\$5). Please bring CASH – small notes most appreciated. Volunteers are needed on the day to take money and assist with service of food.

One task for which we need volunteers is the sale of ANZAC Day merchandise. If anyone would be happy to take control of setting up the purchasing of merchandise and a sales team roster, please contact the Office ASAP. (info@rslmalenv.org.au).

We have a COVID management plan in place so expect to sign in (QR code or manual) when you enter the Hall. Names of people marching with the Veterans' contingent will be taken before the March. Other organisations are expected to take the names of their marchers.

Organisations and individuals who want to lay a tribute at the Cenotaph are encouraged to go to Rosetta Books and buy a book for one of our schools. These books will be collected after the main service, sorted and given to the nominated schools. Please mark the name of your preferred school on the outside of the book wrapping.

As Friday 02 April is **Good Friday**, the Hall will be closed – no bar, no dinner.

Thanks to the **Sunshine Coast Council grants** program, work is progressing on repairs to the Hall. The landing on the western verandah has been renewed, rotten boards replaced etc.

Recently, Sunshine Coast District have established a **Veterans' Health Subsidy Scheme**, the aim of which is to cover out of pocket expenses for a large number of medical treatments and appliances e.g. hearing aids, glasses, specialist visits etc. A copy of the guidelines for the scheme and an application form are attached to this newsletter.

Maleny Show is going ahead on 28 & 29 May, so preparations to operate the coffee tent are underway. This year we have our own tent, suitably emblazoned with the RSL logo. In early May, we will be looking for volunteers to take money and coffee orders and to sell pre-packaged biscuits and cake.
